Tuesday, September 18

INMET Mining will lead a full day tour of the reclaimed Samatosum Mine. Starting at 7:15 a.m. with a continental breakfast and a PowerPoint overview at the conference centre, the tour will start at Johnson Lake fish spillway and spawning channel, continue for a 4.5 hr tour of the mine site, depart to the Adams River spawning grounds before finishing with a dinner at Quaaout Lodge. Return to convention centre around 9:00 pm.
